WGA Efforts on Behalf of the Grocery Industry

- Defeated personal property tax on computers
- Passed legislation to prohibit municipalities from enacting a higher minimum wage than the state
- Increased penalties for shopping cart theft
- Wine sampling law
- Changed law to allow retailers to advertise jointly for liquor
- Beer sampling law (2005-2006)
- Defeated efforts to ban plastic bags
- Increased reimbursement for retailers that sell lottery tickets
